Fri, Apr-04 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Sat, Apr-05 DUBLIN ARRIVAL

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, stop to have breakfast with your group at a local restaurant or pub. Then, journey into Belfast and set off on a guided tour to see the Albert Memorial, the Opera House and Crown Liquor Saloon. You might also view Linen Hall Library, Belfast waterfront and the imposing City Hall, which was completed in 1906. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and settle into your room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink followed by dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

Sun, Apr-06 GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

Today, drive along the coast to experience one of Ireland's popular scenic routes. Here, you'll see the "Nine Glens of Antrim" which offer wonderful views of mountains, valleys and coastline. Continue on to visit the Giant's Causeway, an impressive area of hexagonal columns formed over 60 million years ago by cooling lava, which has given rise to many legends. Then, journey into Bushmills to visit the Bushmills Distillery, which is Ireland's oldest whiskey distillery. See how whiskey is distilled and then try a sample at the end of your tour. After, travel to view the beautiful Dark Hedges, a breathtaking line of beech trees planted in the 18th century. This location was also featured on the television show, Game of Thrones. Head back to your hotel in Belfast, where the remainder of the day is free for independent exploring and dining.

OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

Mon, Apr-07 BELFAST TO WESTPORT

Leaving Belfast, travel to the famous Devenish Island Monastic Site, which includes the best-preserved round tower in Ireland, many ruins, ancient graveyards and high crosses. Continue your journey into Westport and set off on a walking tour of the town, which was created by James Wyatt in 1780 and is one of the few planned towns in Ireland. Among the most picturesque features of the town is the promenade (the Mall) and the little stone bridges along the River Carrow Beg. Transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and settle into your room. This evening, meet your group in the hotel restaurant for a delicious meal.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CASTLECOURT HOTEL, WESTPORT

Tue, Apr-08 ACHILL ISLAND & DESERTED VILLAGE

This morning, travel along Curraun Peninsula to reach Achill Island, joined to the mainland by a bridge. Follow the Atlantic Drive to capture wonderful and wild scenic views of steeply sloped mountains plunging into the shimmering Atlantic Ocean. Stop to view the deserted village, which provides a haunting reminder of times past on Achill Island. Then, head to the Beehive Craft and Coffee Shop to enjoy a delightful lunch with your fellow travelers. Return to your hotel in Westport and spend the balance of the day free to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

OVERNIGHT: CASTLECOURT HOTEL, WESTPORT

Wed, April 9 KYLEMORE ABBEY

After breakfast, travel to visit Kylemore Abbey for a tour of the elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. Learn of the tales of tragedy, romance and royal visits. Also, walk through the magical Victorian walled garden. Continue your drive into Galway and join a local guide for a gentle walking tour of the city. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and the narrow streets. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and spend some time at leisure before dining in the hotel restaurant with your group.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: PARK HOUSE HOTEL, GALWAY

Thu, April 10 ARAN ISLANDS & DUN AENGUS

Today, set off on a short ferry ride from Rossaveal to Inis Mor, the largest of the three Aran Islands. These rocky islands are renowned for the hardy islanders who maintained traditional fishing and farming. The Irish language is still spoken widely. Next, take a minibus ride to Dun Aengus, a huge pre-historic fortress perched on sheer cliffs, which fall away to the Atlantic Ocean below. Have a look around Kilronan before heading back to your hotel in Galway for an evening at leisure.

OVERNIGHT: PARK HOUSE HOTEL, GALWAY

Fri, April 11 CAHERCONNELL SHEEP DOG TRIALS

Departing Galway, travel to visit Caherconnell Farm, where you will have the opportunity to experience farm life and see sheepdogs, working in their natural environment. Next, drive along the coast of scenic County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most beloved, natural landmarks. See magical vistas, overlooking the shimmering Atlantic Ocean along with Ireland's Western coastline. Then, continue into Liscannor to visit St. Brigid's Well, located within a stone well house where pilgrims leave offerings and perform other ritualized activities. Transfer to your hotel in Spanish Point, check in and settle into your room. Tonight, join your group for a wonderful farewell dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: ARMADA HOTEL, SPANISH POINT

Sat, April 12 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES
